Butch has backed every luminary from Frank Sinatra to Count Basie. He has appeared at the Newport Jazz Festival in New York every year since 1975. He has performed at the Gande Parade Du Jazz in Nice, France seven times. In short, Mr. Miles has presented this American art form known as jazz all over the world from Berlin, Germany to Central America and the Caribbean, and now to northern Arizona. As a noted clinician, Butch Miles has held drum clinics internationally for the Ludwig Drum Company.
